



Electronics Recycling Drop Off

The Solid Waste District offers multiple days for residents to recycle computers, TVs, cell phones, VCRs, etc.

What: All computer and television systems

When: 2nd and 3rd Saturdays · (April through September)

Hours: 9 A.M. - 1 P.M.

Where: Butler County Engineer's Office, 1921 Fairgrove Ave. Hamilton, 45011

Limit: 5 computer systems and 2 televisions per household



Freon Appliance Collection

Butler County provides residents with a curbside "on-demand" Freon Appliance recycling program at no charge.

What: refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner or dehumidifier

When: April through September

Call: Unwanted Appliances at 1-888-886-9268 to schedule

Freon Appliances must be placed at the curb or on a driveway. Freon technicians will remove the Freon from your appliances.

Limit: Two "like" appliances per household.

For example,

no more than two refrigerators, two freezers or two air conditioners.



Household Hazardous Drop Off

Dispose of your hazardous items in a safe, environmentally acceptable manner.

What: Paint, automotive fluids, oil, pesticides, pool chemicals, long fluorescent tubes, compact fluorescent bulbs, varnishes, lacquers, antifreeze, car and household batteries and adhesives

When: Every Thursday · (June through September)

Hours: 2 P.M. - 7 P.M.
