**- Trails Alignment Review**

*Bryan Behrmann presented the overall map then discussed each section of map so the committee could discuss the details.*

- The Committee reviewed each section of the map discussing the details of the trails in those areas. The committee identified;
  - o Critical Connection Sections of the existing trail system
    - Steps at the Wetlands.
    - Areas between the homes and SR 129.
      - Possible solution to work with ODOT to bring the trail to the other side of the noise barrier.
- Discussion continued about the opportunities of the existing railroad underpasses. Mr. Behrmann pressed an example of one.

- The committee discussion for each section continued. Key connections, improvements and additions included;
  - o The Van Gordon link to Carriage Hill.
  - o Wider trails on Millikin Road.
  - o The Committee noted the existing sidewalks on the east side of Lesourdsville West Chester Road from Millikin to Hancock Trail was not identified on the map.
- Discussion continued about pedestrian opportunities around the proposed Millikin interchange as well as the new subdivisions recently approved on the north side of Millikin near Tilbury Trail and the pedestrian opportunities those subdivisions presented.
- **Homework**
  - Mr. Behrmann told the committee we would be looking at the commercial corridors on the east side of the township. Mr. Behrmann suggested looking at the Pedestrian Feasibility Study.
