Cincinnati-Dayton Road Shared Use Path Update

Contractors for Liberty Township and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) are constructing a shared use path along the west side of Cincinnati-Dayton Road, between Liberty Way/Hamilton Mason Road and Yankee Road. Construction of the 1/2-mile pedestrian and bike path also includes the installation of curb ramps and crosswalks at the SR 129 ramp



intersections. The project will greatly improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists along the busy corridor. Throughout most of the project, traffic will be maintained on adjacent roadways with intermittent lane restrictions. Access to adjacent properties will also be maintained during construction.
