News from the Fire Department

(LTFD) is happy to report the arrival of the new Tower 113 ladder truck. The new truck is the replacement for the engine that was damaged in an accident on I-75 in July 2019. Tower 113 reaches 100' high, weighs just over 80,000 pounds, seats five personnel and has just over 2000' of fire hose on it! The engine is also the first piece of fire apparatus with the LTFD's new paint scheme and striping package. Tower 113 will be housed at Fire Station 113 on Princeton-Glendale Road.
