## LOCATIONS & AMENITIES

### 1. ALLEN PARK

5440 Joann Drive (45044): 26 acres  
Park features a prairie wildlife habitat.

### 2. CHEROKEE PARK

4616 Watoga Drive (45011): 30.5 acres  
This park has a fishing pond with hiking trails and wildlife habitats along Gregory Creek.

### 3. DUDLEY MEMORIAL PARK

5700 Yankee Road (45044): 11.4 acres  
Popular family-use park with boundless playground, shelters, hiking trails, and fishing pond.

### 4. DUDLEY WOODS PARK "The William F. & Cora Dudley Memorial Park"

5591 Hankins Road (45011): 63 acres  
Park features native wildlife hiking along Gregory Creek.

### 5. FORT LIBERTY PLAYLAND

6845 Van Gorden Road (45011): 7.5 acres  
Amenities here include a popular playground for children and two shelters with paved access to Reserves Park.

### 6. LIBERTY PARK

6757 Yankee Road (45044): 16.5 acres  
This park is adjacent to the Lakota Family YMCA and is used for soccer and Township events.

### 7. MAUD HUGHES INCLINE

6791 Maud Hughes Road (45011)  
This section of the hike and bike trail derives its name from the unique use of bicycle stairs.

### 8. MILL CREEK PRESERVE

Deer Ridge Court (45011): 13 acres  
This is an undeveloped nature habitat.

### 9. RESERVES PARK

5119 Grandin Ridge Drive (45011): 8.6 acres  
Pocket park with almost one mile of hard surface paths, plus a boundless playground, large shelter, a 9-hole disc golf course and fishing pond.

### 10. TURNBRIDGE PARK

5889 Laurel Run Drive (45011): 45 acres  
New park featuring over a mile of paved path.

### 11. WETLANDS

6950 LeSourdsville West Chester Road (45011): 42 acres  
Four unique ponds offer a variety of habitats for wildlife.

### 12. WILHELMINA

6900 Wilhelmina Park (45044): 54.5 acres  
Walking path and park shelter.
